The Chamber was established in December 1994.

The American Chamber of Commerce's mission is to strengthen economic relations between U.S. and Bulgarian commercial enterprises within the framework of the U.S.- European transatlantic economic relations, as well as to further improve the business climate in Bulgaria.

AmCham Bulgaria is an affiliate of the U.S. Chamber of Commerce and a member of the European Council of American Chambers of Commerce (ECACC).

### How we help

For 14 years now, AmCham is the network of the leaders of the American, Bulgarian and international business community. Through the meetings we arrange and the publications we produce, we keep our members abreast of legislative changes, offer advice on economic matters and provide information of newfound business opportunities within Bulgaria and abroad. We lobby on behalf of our membership legitimate interests. The mission of the Corporate Social Responsibility Committee is to encourage and facilitate responsible business practices among AmCham members and to support them to improve the quality and effectiveness of their CSR programmes and actions. Ad hoc working groups are created for to advise and assist finding solutions to concrete issues. Branch meetings bring together professionals to discuss common issues, to mix and network.

Due to our good relations with the U.S. Embassy, we have been successful in representing US business interests within Bulgaria.

# AmCham Membership Categories

Any applicant for membership in the American Chamber of Commerce in Bulgaria [AmCham] - company, NGO or individual - which otherwise complies with the AmCham Statutes, may be granted a regular AmCham membership by the Board of Directors, if it is actively engaged in business with a U.S.-based company(s) and can demonstrate a future ongoing business relationship with the United States or U.S. companies. AmCham membership categories include companies as follows\*:

### For International Members:

---

- i. Registered in Bulgaria company with at least a minimum 51 percent ownership by a foreign entity.
- ii. Registered in Bulgaria trade representative office or subsidiary of a company registered outside Bulgaria with its corporate headquarters located abroad listed on a major stock exchange.
- iii. Registered in Bulgaria company with foreign owned franchise or license.

### For Local Members:

---

A 100% Bulgarian owned or below 51% owned by a foreign entity company registered in Bulgaria.

### For Associate Members:

---

Not-registered and not-resident in Bulgaria company registered on a major stock exchange.

### For Not-for-Profit Members:

---

Registered in Bulgaria not-government organization or other not-for-profit entity.

### For Individual Members:

---

Bulgarian or foreign persons.

\* The eligibility for AmCham membership of applicant (company, NGO or individual) depends on the Board's case-to-case decision. Even though it may not meet any of the above listed criteria, the applicant can still be a subject to further investigation by the Board of Directors. If the Board deems the applicant one of strategic importance to the AmCham members, the Board can approve the candidate on this ground.

### Conferences

---

AmCham Bulgaria organizes high-profile local and regional conferences. Business seniors, political speakers, government representatives, and diplomats are invited to discuss topics pertinent to the Bulgarian and/or global Economy.

In 2008 together with the German-Bulgarian Chamber of Industry and Commerce AmCham organized the conference: "EU-U.S. Economic Partnership: Fair and Transparent Business Environment". 140 participants from both chambers met with Deputy Prime Minister Meglena Plugchieva, Minister of Transport Petar Mutafchiev, Minister of Labor Emilia Maslarova, Minister of Environment and Water Djevdet Chakarov, Deputy minister of Finance Lyubomir Datzov and the Deputy minister of Economy and Energy Yavor Kujumdjiev.

The conference focused on the issues of the development of better economic policy coordination between EU members countries, improvement of the EU public finance, sustained stable economic growth and employment, advanced internal market and business environment, including a flexible labour market, knowledgeable society and environment protection. In addition, the subjects of competitiveness, investments, access to finance, EU funds absorption, improving of the administrative burdens, and regulations were also discussed at the forum.

AmCham organized also Business Discussion "US\_EU Transatlantic Relations: Addressing Global Economic Challenges". The discussion focused on the challenges to the world economy and financial markets and the enhanced cooperation between EU and US to restore global growth and achieve needed reforms in the world's financial systems. European Affairs Minister Gergana Gruncharova, Ambassador Nancy McEldowney, French Ambassador Etienne de Poncins, and business representatives Bernard Moscheni, BTC, Peter Lithgow, AES and journalist Assen Grigorov were keynote speakers at the forum.

### Seminars

---

AmCham organizes seminars and discussions for all members or for targeted groups. The frequency of the meetings and topics can be suggested by the member companies. The purpose of the seminars vary from alerting or educating the participants on an issue, to coming up with position papers addressed to decision-makers from the state administration as a reaction to a particular problem affecting the business environment.

In 2008 AmCham organized a Training with Ecopack on the new regulations affecting the management of certain common types of waste.

### Business Luncheons

---

AmCham business luncheons bring together AmCham members and key decision-makers from Bulgaria, US or international organizations, providing a forum for an open dialogue.

Once a month AmCham members gather for lunch with a guest speaker, followed by a question-and-answer session. Some of our prominent speakers in 2008 were: Boyko Borisov, Mayor of Sofia, Petar Dimitrov, Minister of Economy and Energy, Miglena Tacheva, Minister of Justice, H.E. Nancy McEldowney, U.S. Ambassador to Bulgaria.
